



The master's degree in European Citizenship Institutions and Policies

is offered by the Department of Legal Sciences of the University of Udine (North-East Italy, Friuli Venezia Giulia Region, on the border with Austria and Slovenia).

Aims of the Course of Studies

- to discover the opportunities granted by European citizenship
- to understand the political, economic and cultural dynamics of Europe
- to learn how to write and manage EU projects
- to develop decision-making skills
- to develop cultural mediation skills.

Teaching Contents

Law, economics, political-social sciences, languages, history and philosophy.

Employment Opportunities

Employment in the public and private sectors, at all levels (international, European, national or local), in managing and decision-making positions where knowledge of European institutions, regulations and policies is required.

Languages of Instruction

Italian and English, students learn technical terms in both languages.

The University of Udine

Founded in 1978, the University of Udine quickly established itself among the most innovative and complete academic institutions, at a national and international level. It is a generalist university that stands out for its courses linked to the development of society and new professions. Its quality is demonstrated both by the employment placement record rates of graduates and by the second place in the Italian ranking of medium-sized Italian universities. The master's degree in *Citizenship, European Institutions and Policies* is in line with the spirit of the University: strong roots in the territory and projection into a European cross-border dimension.

The Department of Legal Sciences

In addition to the master's degree in *Citizenship, Institutions and European Policies*, the Department offers a bachelor's and master's degree in Law for Businesses and Institutions, and a five years master's degree in Jurisprudence (for future lawyers and judges). The teaching staff includes experts in all legal subjects, but also scholars of political science and philosophy of politics and law. The Department avails itself of the collaboration of faculty from other Departments. The Department is based in a prestigious historic newly restored building in the city centre.



UDINE AND THE FRIULI VENEZIA GIULIA REGION

Udine is a city of around one hundred thousand inhabitants: safe, welcoming, elegant, liveable, comfortable. Although it is quiet, it offers a lot in terms of architecture, art, culture, music, sports and entertainment. Born as a Germanic city, it was an imperial territory, capital of the important patriarchate of Aquileia, Venetian dominion, part of the Austro-Hungarian empire. Il Sole 24 Ore, the most prestigious Italian business newspaper, has ranked Udine as the Italian province with the highest quality of life (December 2023).

The city occupies the center of the Friuli Venezia Giulia region, which within a radius of one hundred kilometers hosts a compendium of different environments: seas, lakes, plains, hills and mountains.

The Region is a traditional meeting and contamination point between three different cultures and civilizations: Latin, Germanic and Slavic. Its proximity to Venice, Graz, Ljubljana and Zagreb testifies to its European identity: it is the perfect environment to experience the complex dimensions of European identity that are studied in the master's degree in European Citizenship, Institutions and Policies.

Admission Requirements

- A three years bachelor's degree, with at least overall 48 ECTS in some core disciplines (law, social and political sciences, languages, economics, history or philosophy)
- Language skills: Italian (at least B2) and English (at least B1)
- Admission is subject to an oral interview which can also be carried out online.

Application Deadline

There is no fixed deadline for European citizens, but application before the beginning of classes is recommended. Non-European citizens must follow the annual deadlines of the Italian Ministry of University.

- Exams session: May to July and September
